DSGL Exemptions (http://www.defence.gov.au/ExportControls/DSGL.asp)

- ✓ Basic scientific research: experimental or theoretical work undertaken principally to acquire new knowledge of the fundamental principles of phenomena or observable facts, not primarily directed towards a specific practical aim or objective. Similar to Australian Bureau of Statistics and Statistics New Zealand's pure basic research definition (experimental and theoretical work undertaken to acquire new knowledge without looking for long term benefits other than the advancement of knowledge)
- ✓ Public Domain: (Technology or Software subject to DSGL controls which has been made available
 without restrictions upon its further dissemination. Copyright restrictions do not remove Technology
 or Software from being in the Public Domain)
- ✓ The minimum necessary information for an **actual patent application** regardless of whether it is lodged in Australia or overseas (except nuclear **Technology** listed in Category 0 of Part 2 of the **DSGL**)
- ✓ **Medical equipment** specially designed for medical end-use that incorporates an item controlled by Part 2 of the **DSGL**
- ✓ **Technology** which is the minimum necessary for the **installation**, **operation**, **maintenance** (**checking**) and **repair** of those goods which are not controlled or whose **Export** has been authorised
