

DSGL Exemptions (<http://www.defence.gov.au/ExportControls/DSGL.asp>)

- ✓ **Basic scientific research:** experimental or theoretical work undertaken principally to acquire new knowledge of the fundamental principles of phenomena or observable facts, not primarily directed towards a specific practical aim or objective. Similar to Australian Bureau of Statistics and Statistics New Zealand's *pure basic research* definition (*experimental and theoretical work undertaken to acquire new knowledge without looking for long term benefits other than the advancement of knowledge*)
- ✓ **Public Domain:** (**Technology** or **Software** subject to **DSGL** controls which has been made available without restrictions upon its further dissemination. Copyright restrictions do not remove **Technology** or **Software** from being in the **Public Domain**)
- ✓ The minimum necessary information for an **actual patent application** regardless of whether it is lodged in Australia or overseas (except nuclear **Technology** listed in Category 0 of Part 2 of the **DSGL**)
- ✓ **Medical equipment** specially designed for medical end-use that incorporates an item controlled by Part 2 of the **DSGL**
- ✓ **Technology** which is the minimum necessary for the **installation, operation, maintenance (checking) and repair** of those goods which are not controlled or whose **Export** has been authorised
