

Day-1 Pilot Quick Reference Checklist for Researchers

What you need to do in My Research

- Log in to [MyResearch](#) to start your [Application in MyResearch](#)
- Locate and select the round you want to apply for:
 - “MRFF Genomics Health Futures” - Round activated 12 January 2026
 - “Fight MND” - Round activated 12 January 2026
 - “ARC Linkage” - Round activated 15 January 2026
- Complete and Submit your [Application in MyResearch](#) (FAC)
- Attend one of the Pilot Briefing Sessions
 - [Pilot Briefing Session Monday 12 January 2026](#)
 - [Pilot Briefing Session Wednesday 14 January 2026](#)
- Enter the ARC Linkage ID in your MyResearch Application (if applicable) to save time
- When your application is ready for review, email the [Research Office](#) with subject - I am ready for review. Do not attach the application (FAC).

Key things to know

- ✓ FAC is replaced by the system-based [MyResearch Application](#)
- ✓ Any UQ staff member with a current UQ staff email address can help prepare an application in MyResearch.
- ✓ Students can't prepare or submit applications on your behalf
- ✓ The Lead CI must be a UQ staff member to submit the application.
- ✓ HoU and HoU Advisors will receive a notification to review your application
- ✓ You can ask Local Research Support and the Research Office for help with your funding application at any time
- ✓ You can ask the [MyResearch team](#) for help with the system at any time
